FOR YOUR ATTENTION - as you may have heard, there will be road works in Queen Street over easter - Richard has ascertained the following:

Access into Queen St from Newcastle St will continue to be open, however the road will be closed between 8am and 330pm just after the opening into the Crossing car park and the Bus Station entrance opposite. There will be no road access beyond the closure other than emergency access.

When leaving The Crossing car park we will turn left back onto Queen St and then Newcastle St ie the one way system on Queen St will be suspended (this may be a bit tricky with buses coming in etc so take care!)

The Highways team's understanding is the Queen St public car park will be closed during the works.

IT IS INTENDED that the prohibitions respecting the above road or roads will apply as follows: From 08:00 hours on Tuesday 26th March 2024 Until 15:00 hours on Wednesday 4th April 2024
